On 21st August, 2012, Mr. Shigenobu Kobayashi, Charge'd'affaires of the Embassy of Japan in Malawi and Honorable Richie Bizwik Muheya, Minister of Water Development and Irrigation celebrated the official handover of the natural disaster mitigation equipment. The Government of Japan provided 500 million Japanese Yen (about 1.8 billion kwacha at the present value) for the Improvement of Capabilities to cope with National Disasters Programme. The programme provided heavy machineries including bulldozers, sheep foot rollers, drilling machines, all of which are expected to be utilized for disaster prevention.
