The Government of Japan on 7th September, 2012 awarded Development Aid from People to People in Malawi (DAPP Malawi) a grant amounting to \$98,710 under the Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects for constructing an additional accommodation facility for trainee teachers at DAPP Amalika Teachers' Training College in Thyolo district.

It is envisaged that DAPP Amalika Teachers' Training College will be able to accommodate 32 additional trainees and increase the number of qualified teachers to provide quality education to pupils living in rural areas.
