On 7th December, 2012 His Excellency Fujio Samukawa, The Ambassador of Japan to Malawi handed over two school blocks with two classrooms each and 140 pupils' desks to Blantyre City Council for Ndirande Hill View Primary School in the presence of Hon. Aaron Sangala, Member of Parliament. The Government of Japan on 4th August, 2010 extended a grant amounting to \$53,114 to the Blantyre City Council for the project under the Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects. These new school blocks will assist in providing a conducive learning environment through easing the problem of classroom shortages as there are only 8 classrooms to cater for about 2,300 pupils.
