The Government of Japan on 5th September, 2012 awarded a grant to Nkhoma CCAP Hospital amounting to \$18,081 for the Project for Procurement of a Recycled Ambulance. The ambulance is a donation from Shioya Fire Department in Tochigi Prefecture in Japan. The contract agreement for the project was signed on between His Excellency Fujio Samukawa, Ambassador of Japan to Malawi and Dr. Reynier Ter Haar, Medical Director of Nkhoma CCAP Hospital. Established in 1915, Nkhoma CCAP Hospital serves over 250,000 people living in Nkhoma, Lilongwe Rural and Dedza District. The ambulance is expected to assist the Hospital to transfer referral cases to Kamuzu Central Hospital for further treatment.
