On 23rd August, 2012, Mr. Shigenobu Kobayashi, Charge'd'affaires of the Embassy of Japan and Honorable Mohammed Sidik Mia, Minister of Transport and Public Works celebrated the official inauguration of the new South Rukuru Bridge in Rumphi District. The Government of Japan provided 994 million Japanese Yen (about 3 billion kwacha at the present value) for the replacement and reconstruction of the South Rukuru Bridge project. Completion of the South Rukuru Bridge is expected to improve the flow of traffic drastically and also promote international trade with the neighboring countries.
