On 15th May, 2012 His Excellency Fujio Samukawa, Ambassador of Japan to Malawi signed over funds amounting to \$12, 143 (about K3 million) to Ngwenya LEA School as a follow-up expense for the construction of three school blocks at the school. The Government of Japan first extended a grant amounting to \$111,627 (about MK 16,967,413) to the school under the Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects on 8th September, 2011. The Head Teacher of Ngwenya LEA School, Mr. Victor Kwacheramwina signed the contract on behalf of the school. Once completed, the project is expected to provide a more conducive learning environment for the pupils. The school is one of the schools in the country with a massive enrolment of 8,550 children .
