The Ambassador of Japan in Malawi His Excellency Mr. Fujio Samukawa witnessed the groundbreaking ceremony at Mseche CDSS for the expansion and rehabilitation of the school. The Guest of Honour was the Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology responsible for Primary and Basic Education Mr. Wictor Songazaudzu Sajeni. Mseche CDSS is one of the six schools being re-constructed and expanded through a grant aid amounting to 1.2 Billion Yen (about 1.8 Billion Kwacha) for the improvement of 6 Community Day Secondary Schools in the central and southern regions of Malawi which the Government of Japan provided to the Government of Malawi through the Ministry of Finance on 21st August, 2010. After completion, the school is expected to provide access to quality secondary education to many students as currently the school has only two school blocks.
