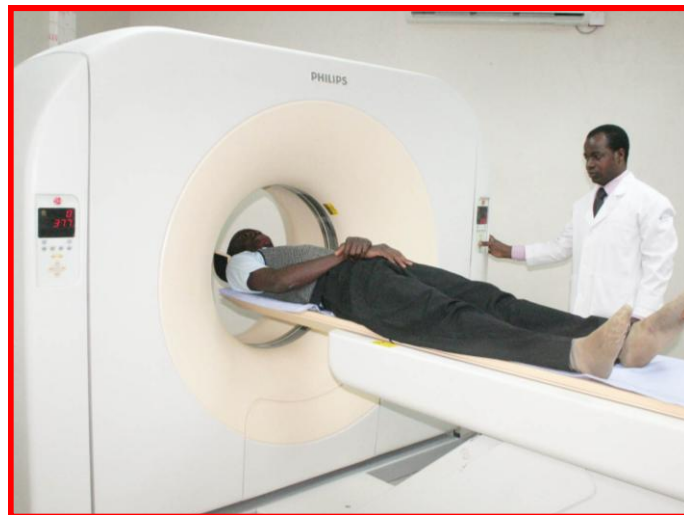


Grant Assistance for Grassroots' Human Security Projects

His Excellency, Mr. Fujio Samukawa, Ambassador of Japan to Malawi handed over a CT scanner to Daeyang Luke Mission through a grant amounting to \$212,000 (about K35, 000,000) under the Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects on Wednesday, 19th October, 2011. The CT scanner will enable medical personnel to diagnose invisible diseases ranging from heart and brain diseases to many other disorders. The facility will assist medical experts to make informed decisions on the best treatment to provide to patients as the diseases will be clear. Daeyang Luke will also be able to train radiology personnel and other medical trainees in Lilongwe how to operate the scanner and also how to interpret results from the readings.
